## Soo Locks

Distance from downtown:

Walkable

1 1/2 - 2 hours

The Soo Locks Park is home to the Soo Locks Visitors Center, which offers a wealth of information on the engineering marvel, and the Observation Deck that hovers over the locks. ## Museum Ship Valley Camp

The Museum Ship Valley Camp is a retired freighter that's become a hallmark of downtown Sault Ste. Marie. The freighter is now host to a nautical museum that doesn't just retell the history of the Valley Camp, but many of the legends of the Great Lakes. Don't miss your chance to see an exhibit from the Edmund Fitzgerald located inside the Valley Camp.

## River of History Museum

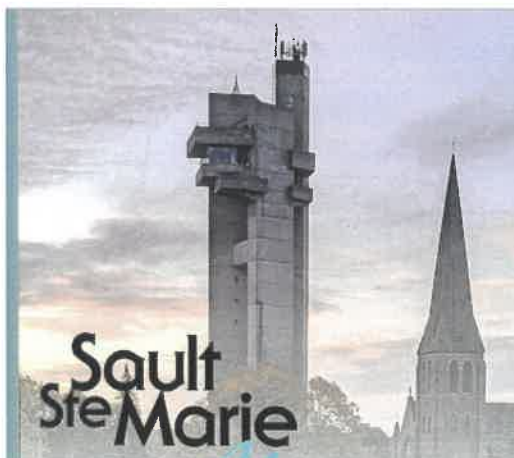
Distance from downtown:

## Tower of History

Distance from downtown:

1 hour - 1 1/2 hour

Nowhere in the Soo offers the views that the Tower of History does. Soar 210 feet above the city and capture a bird's eye view of landmarks throughout downtown Sault Ste. Marie and along the Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario waterfront. On top of unbeatable views, the tower offers an exhibit on the ground level that dives into the city's history.
